

Talking about vaccination with expectant parents

Vaccine decision-making begins in pregnacy. To support vaccine acceptance and uptake:

1. Recommend vaccination

• Use your preferred language: "It is recommended" or "I recommend"

2. Elicit questions

- Use open-ended questions: "What questions do you have?"
- Summarise concerns

3. Share knowledge

- Ask permission to share knowledge
- Share facts on vaccine safety and effectiveness
- Use resources at MumBubVax.org.au

4. Discuss disease severity

Centre discussion on disease, not vaccines

5. Facilitate vaccination

• Vaccinate if possible, or explain where to go

6. Continue the conversation

- Offer childhood vaccination information on SKAI website: talkingaboutimmunisation.org.au
- Keep communication open
